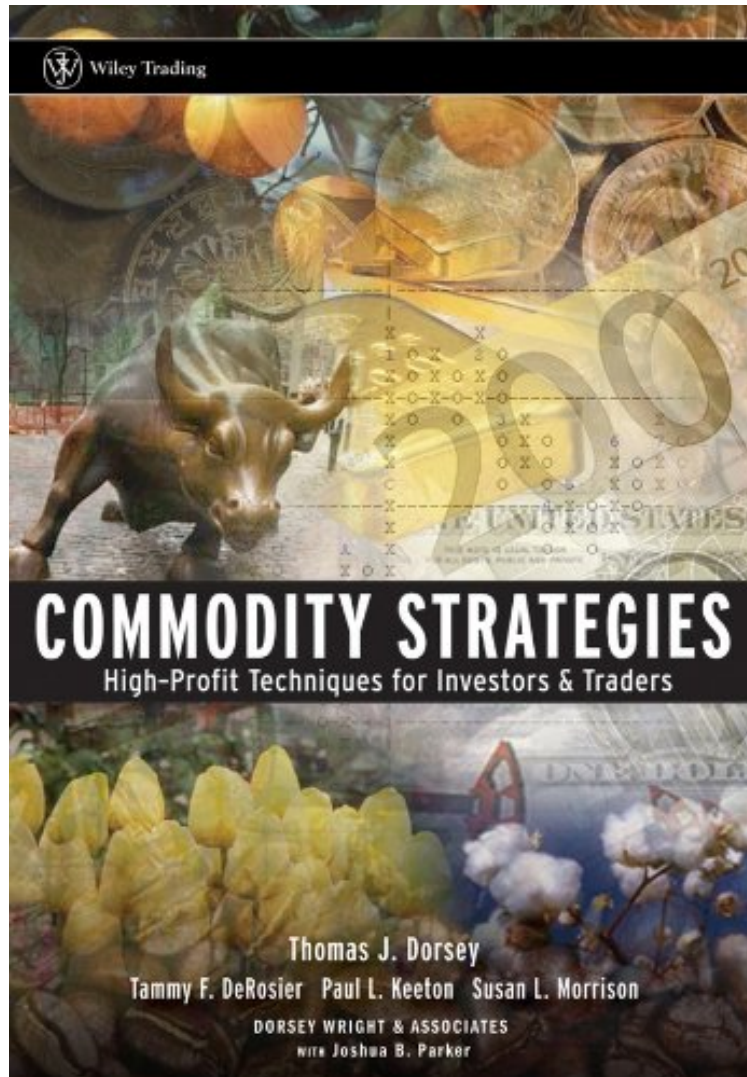

The author is candid about this from the outset and there are many great books that cover that already - Teweles and Jones among them. This book is ideal for traders

already experienced in point and figure technical analysis and especially for those who have read and applied Dorsey Wright's point and figure methodology. If this book is the first you are reading that deals exclusively in point and figure technical analysis, you may be disappointed. Tom Dorsey's other books are a prerequisite to this one. A very valuable book for experienced point and figure craftsmen looking to apply such analysis to futures markets, but admittedly it may leave others feeling short changed.
