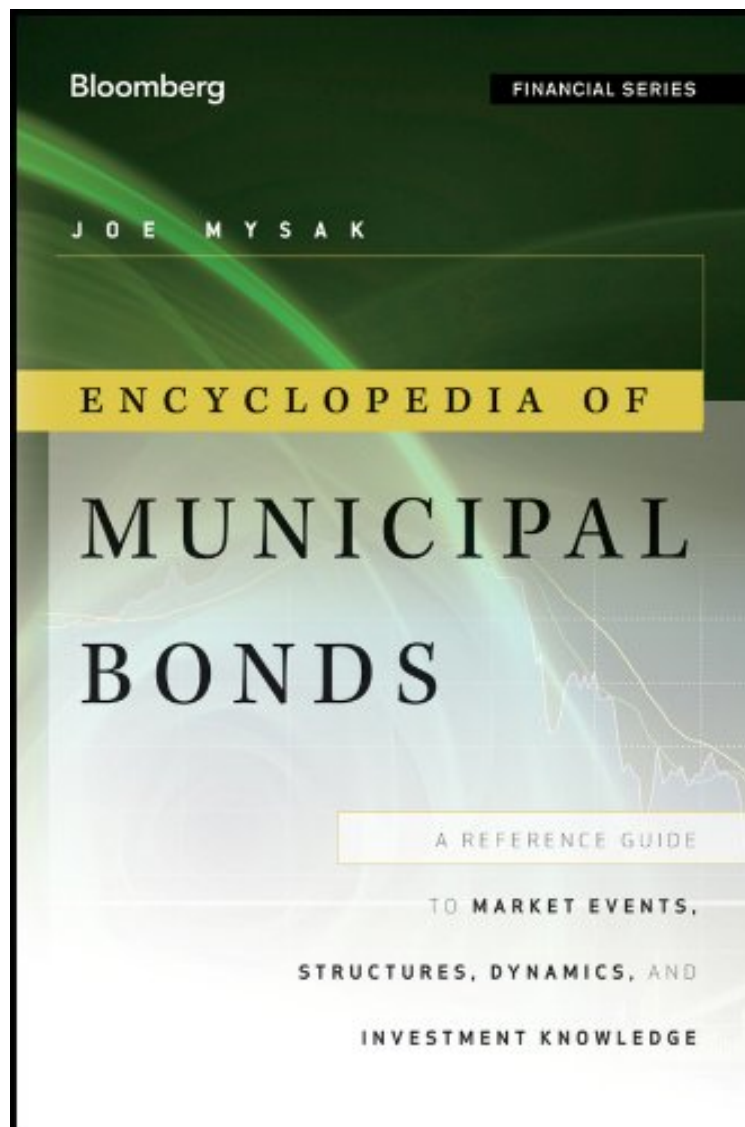

I think it should be forced upon every new employee in the municipal world.
