A few anecdotal quotes are included from property managers who explain their career paths. Some trade association surveys and Bureau of Labor Statistics data are

cited. The context is mostly rental properties; there is one page about Homeowners Associations. The author is a communications manager with the National Association of Realtors and was previously editor of the Journal of Property Management for 20 years. She has experience writing about real estate, but she has no personal experience to share as a property manager. The book is well written and can be read quickly, although there is one style point I find annoying. Several times the author refers to "an REIT." REIT, an acronym which stands for Real Estate Investment Trust, is pronounced "reet" so it would be grammatically proper to say "a REIT."
