As for the content of the book, Toni Turner has to be one of the most entertaining writers on this topic. She has a great sense of humor. More importantly, she distills concepts so that they can be grasped by the most novice of traders. In particular, I did appreciate her breaking it down into steps. It did help tremendously in organizing my thoughts. The template she provided for writing your

particular trading plan is a real gift. Trend trading is not for the meek. Clearly, big mistakes can be devastating to your portfolio. The author repeatedly emphasizes the importance of capital preservation and the tactics one must employ to minimize risk and mitigate the effect of those trades that go against you. I am a technical writer by trade and based on that, am amazed at the clarity and amount of detail Toni Turner packs into each paragraph. Because of that, this shouldn't be the first book to introduce you to the subject, but it should be among the first books you read.
