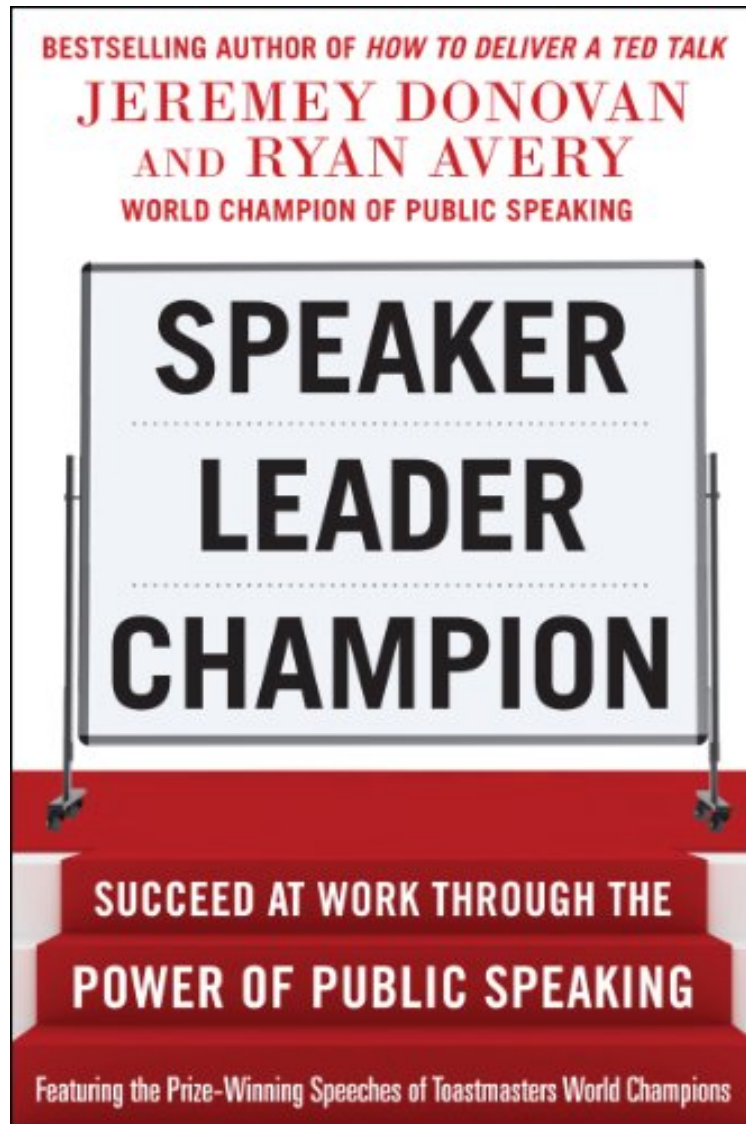

Just having this book's compilation of funny and inspiring speeches would be enough, but also having Donovan and Avery's insights on how to create your own outstanding speeches makes it a real winner. Donovan and Avery make several references to great speeches by Abraham Lincoln, Martin Luther King Jr., etc., but the one thing that could make this book even better would be for them to dissect famous, non-Toastmaster speeches in their characteristic style.
