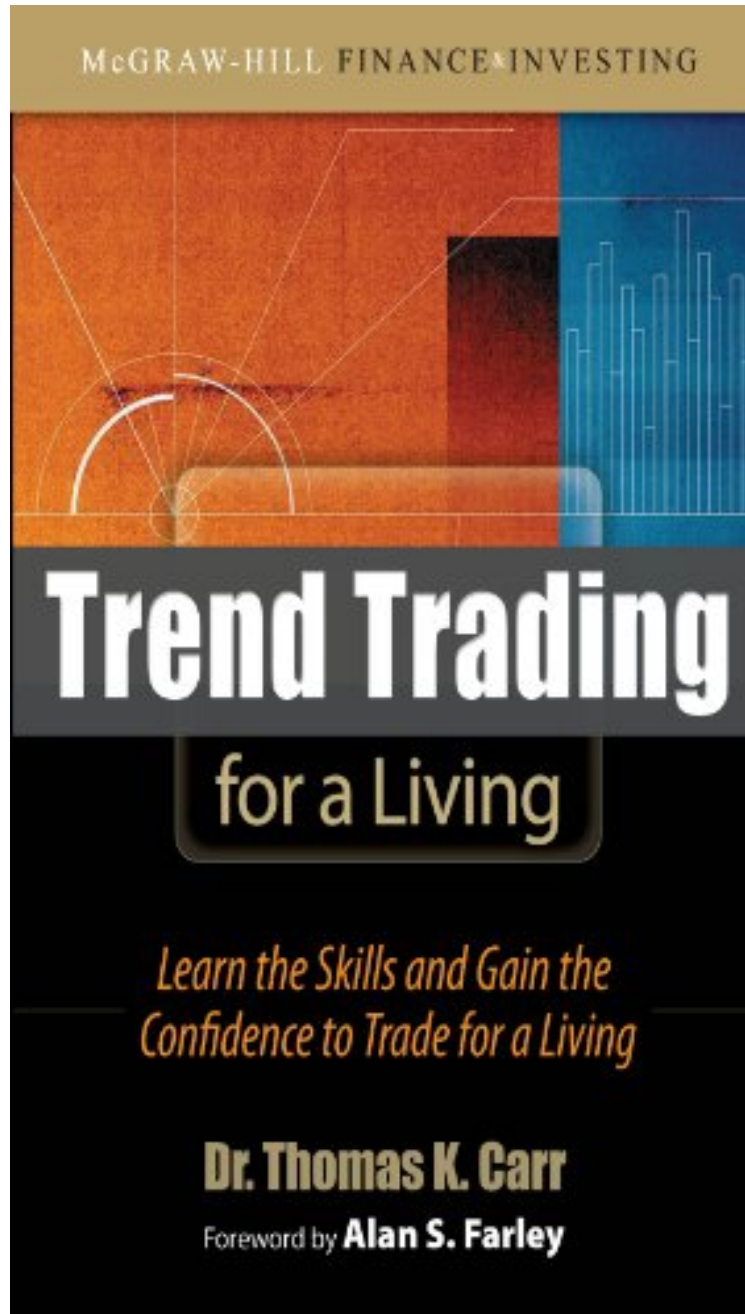

Great discussion of stock pickingBy RichHe really does not address position sizing and risk management for trend trading but instead suggests another book. However, you may not be able to find a better chapter on stock selection than chapter 9 of this book. While some say that stock picking is less important than position sizing and risk management, I think the process for picking trending stocks is the "special sauce" that can really affect your overall profit. I think the addition of the chapters on option trading dilutes the book and this book should have focused on aspects of trend trading stocks. His discussion of general market direction and Beta is pretty good and the discussion of exit criteria is certainly good enough. Chapter 9 is the real jewel in this book and the discussion on general market direction is also good. Skim the rest.
