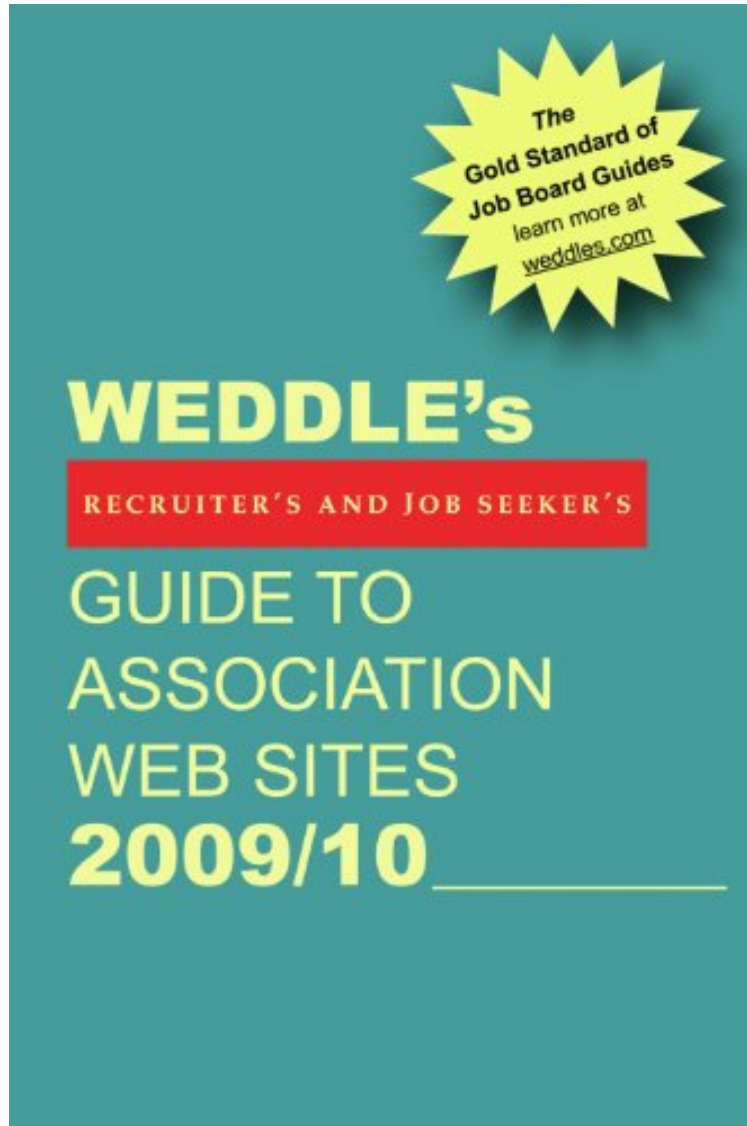

When I hit a wall doing some research for a particularly difficult search, I ordered this book. It provided me with names for about six organizations of which three had resume databases/job boards. Because I was scouring the book for help, I did notice some organizations appear more than once under different headings. Originally I thought this diminished the value of the resource, then realized most people would not digest the book cover to cover as I did. Far from a silver bullet, it is a reasonable source to turn to for additional sources when engaged in a difficult search.
